Skin – fluffy, hairy, scaly, spiky, colour

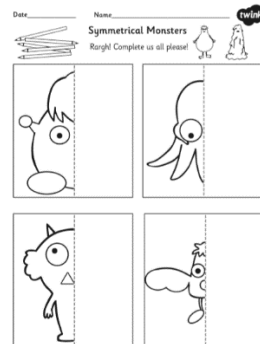
What does your monster eat?

Where do they live?

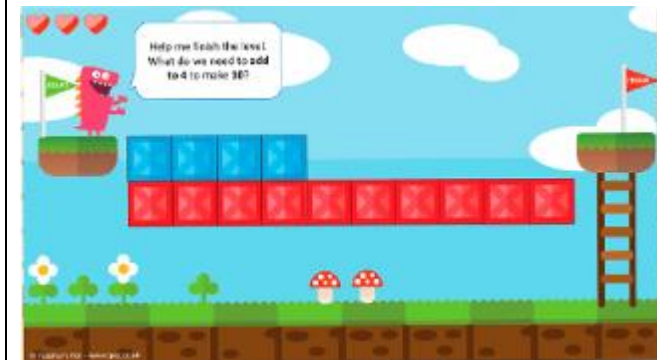
## Monster Symmetry
