

Capacity Game

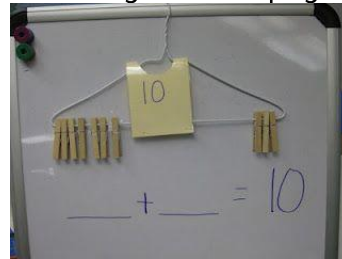


Click on the picture to play this capacity game.

For this challenge, you will need lots of different cups.



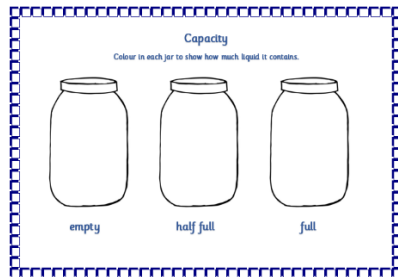
Which might you choose if you wanted a lot to drink? Why?

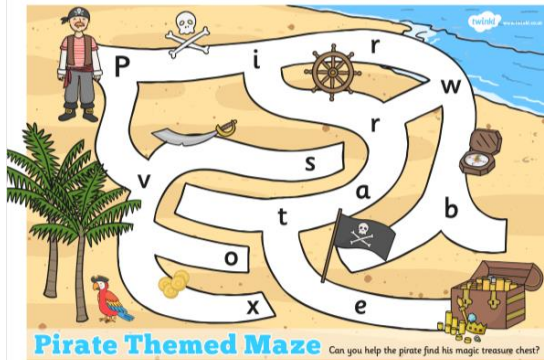

Art

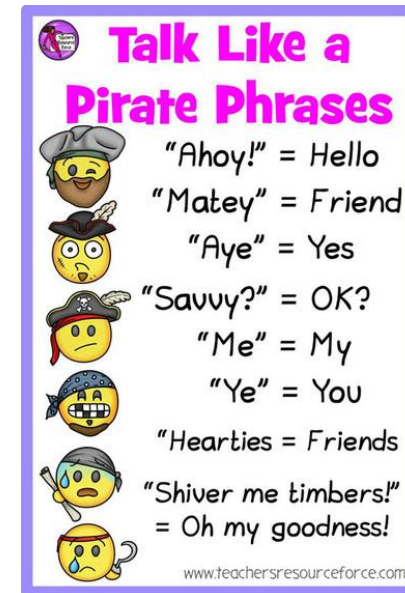
Tea and Coffee painting (see pdf)
